- 3) The Adobe Video Bundle - delivers Adobe video solutions coupled with Flash Professional 8.

Their plans for the future of their software applications are not specific at this time. Here is an excerpt from the FAQ:

Q: How will the product portfolios be integrated over time?

After that, product integration requiring engineering enhancements will come in the first 12 to 18 months as part of regularly scheduled product upgrade cycles.
